## The Purpose of Ecclesia "The Church" (October 8, 2023)

## Definitions:

- 1. The Church is not simply a \_\_\_\_\_\_ or \_\_\_\_\_.

   2. The Church is an \_\_\_\_\_\_ (Gathering) of Christ-followers (1 Cor. 12, 1 Cor. 6:19)

Vs 42 All the believers devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching, and to fellowship, and to sharing in meals (including the Lord's Supper), and to prayer.

Vs 43-47 A deep sense of awe came over them all, and the apostles performed many miraculous signs and wonders. And all the believers met together in one place and shared everything they had. They sold their property and possessions and shared the money with those in need.

They worshiped together at the Temple each day, met in homes for the Lord's Supper, and shared their meals with great joy and generosity — all the while praising God and enjoying the goodwill of all the people. And each day the Lord added to their fellowship those who were being saved. (Acts 2:42-46)

## 4 essential purposes... of the 1<sup>st</sup> (and 21<sup>st</sup>) century church

Purpose #1: TO \_\_\_\_\_\_ the SPIRITUAL \_\_\_\_\_

Acts 2:42, All the believers devoted themselves ... to TEACHING Hebrews 10:23-25, Without wavering, let us hold tightly to the hope

## The "Spiritual Drift" is Subtle:

- 1. It's Encased in Deception.
- 2. It's Engaged through Complacency
- 3. It's Extended by Hectic Activity.

4. It Ends with Eternal (Spiritual) Death.

#### Committed Church Involvement Reverses the "Spiritual Drift"!

- 1. Corporate Worship "Draws" believers "Near" to the heart of God.
- 2. Preaching & Teaching God's Word "Exposes" counterfeit doctrine.
- 3. <u>Fellowship provides Accountability through Relationship, which serves as a warning</u> system against sin.
- 4. Corporate Prayer releases Christ's cleansing, healing and miraculous power.

#### AND EACH OTHER. Purpose #2: TO Acts 2:42, "All the believers devoted themselves ... to FELLOWSHIP" <u>Hebrews 10:24</u>, "And let us consider how we may <u>spur one another on</u> toward love and good deeds."

The word "Spur" in the Original language "paroxusmos":

Means:

To Provoke, Prod or Incite. To Rouse or Stir-up. To Love and Good Deeds NOT TO ANGER AND REVENGE

### Frederick W. Burnham (1871-1960) once said,

(He was a Pastor in Richmond, Virginia)

"The business of the ministry is to comfort the afflicted and afflict the comfortable.

# Purpose #3: TO \_\_\_\_\_\_ AND TO \_\_\_\_\_

Acts 2:42, "All the believers devoted themselves ... TO SHARING in meals (including the Lord's Supper)

Vs 45 And all the believers met together in one place and SHARED EVERYTHING they had. They sold their property and possessions and SHARED THE MONEY with those in need.

Hebrews 10:25b "...but let us encourage one another — and all the more as you see the Day approaching."

The words "Shared EVERYTHING" in the Original language "diamerizó" It means: To Divide and Distribute (as needed)

#### Purpose #4: FOR MUTUAL \_\_\_\_

Acts 2:42, All the believers "devoted themselves... To PRAYER." Hebrews 10:22, "...let us DRAW NEAR TO GOD with a sincere heart and with the full assurance that faith brings."
