I. Who is James?

James, a servant of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ, To the twelve tribes scattered among the nations: Greetings. (James 1:1)

- 1. James is the brother of Jesus.
- 2. James was a skeptic of Jesus.
- 3. James was a follower of Jesus after the Resurrection.
- 4. James becomes the leader of the <u>Jerusalem</u> Church.

II. What is the letter of James?

- 1. The Book of James is for all believers.
- 2. The Book of James is how to live like Jesus, practically.
 - a. Hellenistic culture.
 - b. Skillfully written in Greek.
 - c. For Israel, the New Church.

III. How can we make good decisions in our lives?

- 1. "Consider it pure joy..." (James 1:2)
 - "... know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance." (James 1:3)
 - a. Trials.
 - b. <u>Temptations</u>.

No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it.

(1 Corinthians 10:13)

c. Tests.

- 2. "Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything." (James 1:4)
 - a. Mature.
 - b. Complete.
- 3. "If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you." (James 1:5)
 - a. Wisdom from God is a gift!
 - b. Wisdom from God is generously given!
 - c. Wisdom from God is continuously divine!

But when you ask, you must believe and not doubt, because the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind. That person should not expect to receive anything from the Lord. Such a person is double-minded and unstable in all they do. (James 1:6-8)

- 1. Share a trial, temptation, or testing where God revealed His wisdom to you. What was the benefit of His wisdom in that situation?
- 2. Why do we NOT go to God when His wisdom is generously, divinely, and continually given? Share an example.
- 3. Do you need God's wisdom in your life today? Pray for God to provide for you (and have others pray with you).
